Minute No. AGMiC-2020-11.001 - Welcome & Introductions by the Joint CCG Chair

- 1.1 Dr Povey welcomed members to the NHS Shropshire CCG and NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG Governing Bodies' Annual General Meetings in common for the year ending April 2019-March 2020. It was noted this would be the only joint AGMs in common of the two CCGs owing to plans to dissolve the two CCGs on 31 March 2021 and to create a new single CCG for Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin on 1 April 2021.
- 1.2 The financial year 2019-20 had ended with a very difficult time in Quarter 4 owing to the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic which continued to affect the whole population. Although these AGMs in common would focus on the year 2019-20 there needed to be a reflection on what had happened since 2019-20 which had seen a dramatic change in the health economy. There had been increased system working and a huge thank you was extended on behalf of the Governing Bodies to all staff members working for both CCGs for their effort and dedication to their work during what had been a difficult time for everyone.
- 1.3 It was reported that Katrina Smart, who was a member of the Continuing Healthcare (CHC) Team, had recently passed away and the CCGs' condolences were with Katrina's family.
- 1.4 The process of combining the CCGs, which had commenced in 2019-20, was on-going. An appointment process had led to David Evans being appointed the Joint Accountable Officer (AO) for both NHS Shropshire CCG and NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG. A big thank you was extended to David Stout, who had served as Interim AO for NHS Shropshire CCG until 29 September 2019 before moving to his new post of Chief Executive of Shropshire Community Health Trust (SCHT).
- 1.5 A restructure of the Executive Team had taken place in December 2019 and a thank you was extended to the previous executive directors who were no longer members of the new Joint Executive Team: Jon Cooke, Fran Beck, Christine Morris, Gail Fortes-Mayer, Nicky Wilde and Dr Jessica Sokolov.
- 1.6 The wider restructuring of the CCGs had been paused following the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic. It was appreciated that this had caused stress to staff who were thanked for their patience at this very difficult time and also the support from the CCGs' partners in the Commissioning Support Unit (CSU) for taking the CCGs through that process.
- 1.7 From 1 August 2020, outside of the period of these AGMs, the Governing Body had been restructured, which had seen some Members remain working for the CCGs in different or in similar roles. A big thank you was extended to those Governing Body Members who had left the CCGs: Neil Maybury, Caroline Fenton-West, Dr Alan Leaman, Sarah Porter, Finola Lynch, and Peter Eastaugh.
- 1.8 An acknowledgement of thanks was also extended to Dr Jo Leahy, the previous Chair of Telford and Wrekin CCG for her work in championing the population, primary care and the CCGs. Dr Leahy was missed and the Governing Bodies of both CCGs extended their best wishes to Dr Leahy in her future work going forward.

Minute No. AGMiC-2020-11.006 - Presentation by Executive Director of Finance

- 6.1 Mrs Claire Skidmore, Executive Director of Finance, presented PowerPoint slides, which set out the Financial Performance for the two CCGs in 2019/2020 as follows:
 - NHS Shropshire CCG had received an allocation of £476m in 2019/2020 to commission healthcare for a population of 314,400, which equated to an average of £1,514 per person.
 - Spending on running costs equated to 1% of total expenditure or £22 per person.
 - In 2019/2020 NHS Shropshire CCG delivered an in-year deficit of £47.3m against a target of £15.9m deficit.
 - A breakdown of 2019/2020 expenditure totalling £523m was shown, which provided detail that approximately 50% of the CCG's expenditure was spent on acute services; just under 10% on community services; 10% on mental health services; 10% on complex care placements; and approximately 20% on primary care including prescribing costs.
 - NHS Shropshire CCG's expenditure also included the following services:

- NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG had received an allocation of £263m in 2019/2020 to commission healthcare for a population of 173,000, which equated to an average of £1,520 per person.
- Spending on running costs equated to 2% of total expenditure or £28 per person.
- In 2019/2020 NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG delivered an in-year deficit of £13.1m against a break even target.
- A breakdown of 2019/2020 expenditure totalling £276m was shown, which provided detail that
 approximately 50% of the CCG's expenditure was spent on acute services; just under 7% on
 community services; 10% on mental health services; 9% on complex care placements; and
 approximately 22% on primary care including prescribing costs.
- NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG's expenditure also included the following services:

- 6.2 Summarising, Mrs Skidmore said that it had been a challenging year for both NHS Shropshire CCG and NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG. The CCGs recognised some of the drivers of the financial pressures and were working to address those as best they could by utilising system resource and partnerships to try and improve the CCGs' positions. It was difficult to predict the year-end position because it had been a particularly unusual year, not just operationally but how this was reflected in the CCGs' financial positions.
- 6.3 Dr Povey suggested that it would be helpful for the next AGM meetings to include the number of GP attendances in the presentation slide entitled, 'Where did we spend our money?' which would show the high number of GP attendances and the high cost involved for both CCGs.
- 6.4 Mr Trenchard referred to the CCGs' increasing focus on improving health outcomes and health inequalities and suggested that it would be helpful to encompass information on those outcomes in the next AGM slide sets.



- 7.1 Mr Evans acknowledged that it had been a challenging year. As previously highlighted by the Chair, there had been some significant progress made in some areas but towards the end of the year, following the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, there had been the cessation of a number of services across the system, which the CCGs were still trying to recover from as they moved into the second half of the year.
- 7.2 The CCGs had agreed to formally dissolve and to create a new CCG for Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin. This proposal had been agreed by the membership and whilst the first application had been unsuccessful, the second application had been successful. Mr Evans expressed his gratitude to Miss Alison Smith, Director of Corporate Affairs and to the Members of the Executive Team for their hard work towards achieving that position.
- 7.3 To address the financial positions of both CCGs was going to be a challenge moving forward. The CCGs had not ended the financial year in the positions that they would have wished. Notwithstanding the comments made around the commissioning of care for the population, the CCGs would need to focus on the health outcomes and health improvements in addressing inequalities for the local population moving forward. Some progress had been seen last year, particularly in the Telford Healthy Hearts programme.
- 7.4 Performance last year continued to be problematic, particularly around A&E performance in both local hospitals. Work was on-going to address this and also Shrewsbury and Telford Hospital NHS Trust's (SaTH's) workforce challenge. There had been an increased focus around the quality of care being delivered for patients in SaTH and the CCGs continued to work hard with the regulators to improve the quality of service provision for the local population.
- 7.5 Last year had seen the development of all practices joining Primary Care Networks (PCNs) across both CCGs. This had been very informative and the practices continued the work they had set moving forward working on larger footprints in a more co-operative way whilst retaining their individual businesses. PCNs were going to be an important development in terms of integrated care partnerships (ICPs) as steps were taken to move towards system working and in the redesign of services that enable patients to be treated closer to home.
- 7.6 There had been some good areas of performance, particularly around complex discharges, with low rates of delayed transfers of care, and improvements in the medically fit for discharge numbers within the acute provider. This had been a testament to the partnership working across the whole system. Colleagues at Shropshire Council and Telford and Wrekin Council were thanked for their contribution in reducing the delayed transfer of care rates, which were some of the lowest rates in the country.
- 7.7 Mr Evans echoed Dr Povey's thanks to those members of the Executive Team and Governing Bodies who had left the two CCGs in the past year. A personal thank you was extended to Dr Jo Leahy for her work as Chair of NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG for the past four years and who was greatly missed.
- 7.8 Mr Evans extended a huge thank you to all staff across the two CCGs who had showed a great commitment in working really hard to deliver the CCGs' agendas in a time of significant uncertainty. A special thank you was also expressed to the Members of the Executive Team and Governing Bodies of the two CCGs for their continued support.

7.9 Dr Povey noted that the joint AGMs in common were being recorded and would be published on NHS Shropshire CCG and NHS Telford and Wrekin CCG CCGs' websites together with the CCGs' Annual Reports and Annual Accounts.
